- IIMS
 - Today links to incident scene:
 - Transportation – NYCDOT TMC, NYCDOT OER, JTOC, Region 11 Emergency Response Group
 - Public Works – DOS Operations Center and Brooklyn North Communications Center, DEP (Lefrak), 4 *NYCDOT* Maintenance Yards (Bronx, Brooklyn, Queens and JETS yard in Queens)
 - Public Safety – NYPD TMC, NYPD Division HQ in Queens, Queens Highway Unit, Operations Center (1 Police Plaza), FDNY Metrotech, MTA Police, MTA Bridges and Tunnels Operations
 - Emergency Management – NYCOEM
 - Interfaces to CATS/MICE (shares incident info)

- Incident Response

- On MTA Bridges and Tunnel Facilities, first responder is B&T. The B&T FOC calls NYPD which dispatches FDNY
- How does FDNY determine the HAZMAT on the scene?
- Use the database of vehicle and freight to find vehicle ID then access to the Chemtrak Database of HAZMAT spill information sheet.
- Security
 - Avoiding the hijacking of security sensitive HAZMAT cargoes
