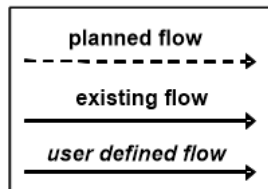
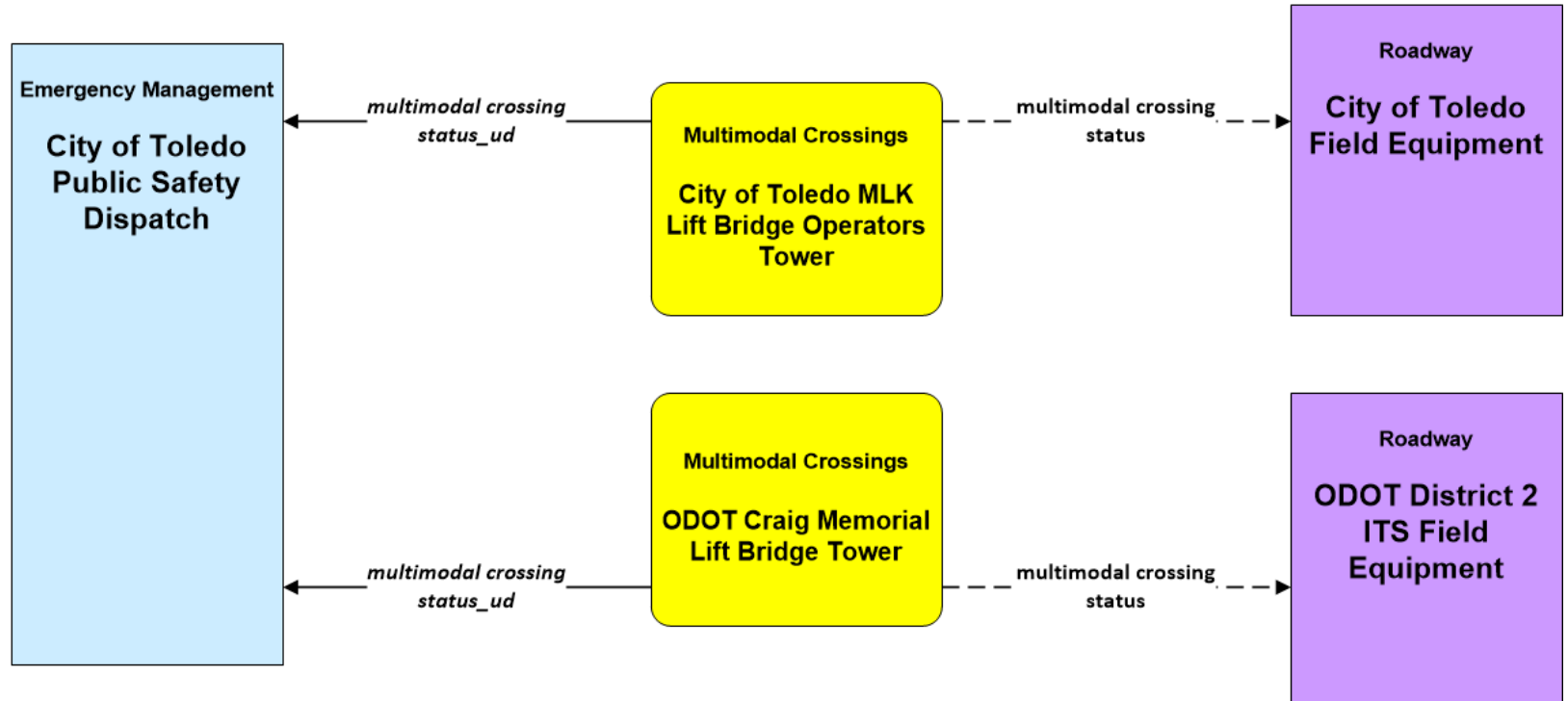
Overview of Comments

Comments on the Webpage: City of Toledo

- Inventory:
 - Updated *City of Toledo Traffic Management System* description
- Functional Requirements:
 - Removed functional requirements for Traffic Metering
- Services
 - Updated ATMS20 to reflect that drawbridge status is sent directly to the City of Toledo Public Safety Dispatch, not the COT TMS
- Projects:
 - Updated the description for COT and Lucas County signal coordination

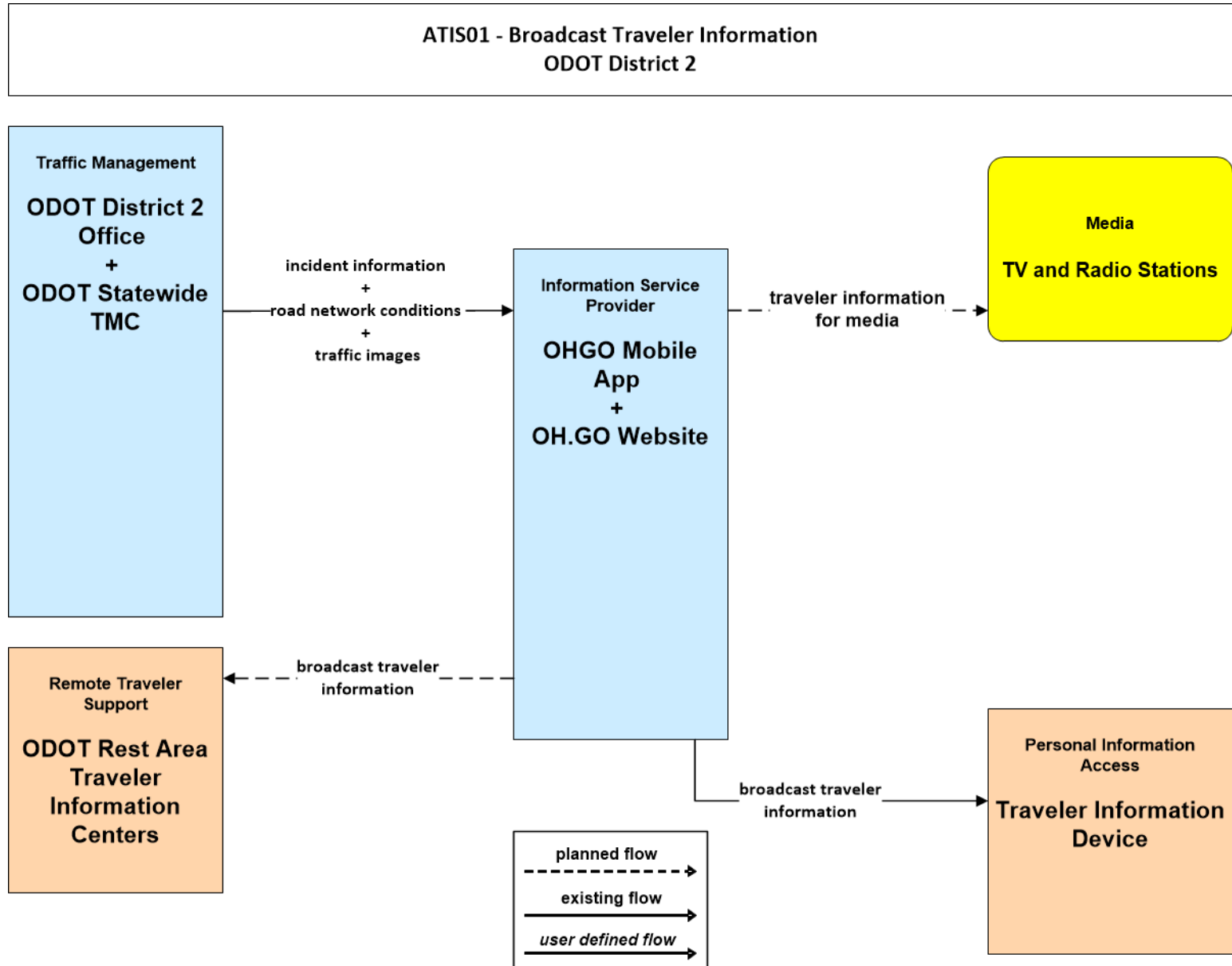
ATMS20 - Lift Bridge Management



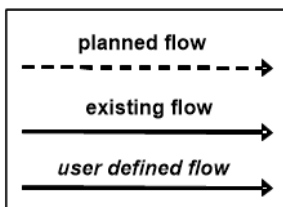
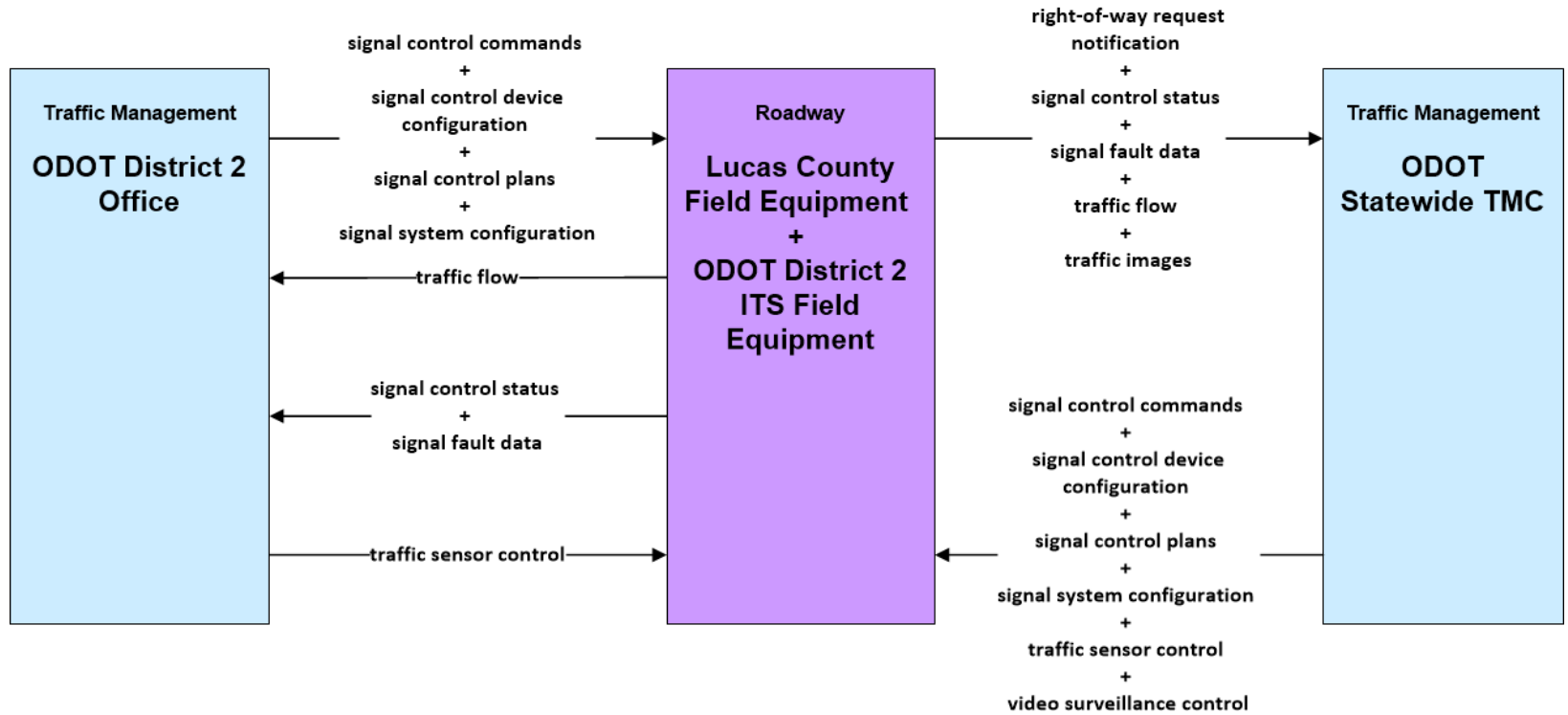
Comments on the Webpage: ODOT

– Services

- ATMS03 – Traffic signal flows are *existing*, not planned
- ITS devices are controlled from the Statewide TMC
- Maintenance information is posted on OHGO.com – these information flows were changed to existing
- OHGO flows to personal devices changed to existing
- Added a planned information flow for *parking information* from OHGO to the Southeast Michigan Traffic Operations Center

- Lucas County Fire Departments
 - Are there multiple fire departments operated by Lucas County?
